School Staff, Parents, Guardians, and Students agree to the following:

- *All Canyon Lake Middle School students must return this contract, signed by parent/guardian and student indicating they understand and will abide by the terms outlined here.
- *Follow the policy outlined in the 2019-2020 LEUSD Student/Parent Rights and Responsibilities Handbook regarding Electronic Signaling Devices, which can be found on pages 15-16, as well as at the bottom of this page.
- *No cell phones, headphones, or ear buds will be allowed out while entering or exiting any classroom.
- *Teachers will use a common daily visual of cell phone, headphones, and ear buds expectation in their classroom.
- *Teachers will provide a daily oral explanation of cell phone, headphones, and ear buds expectation in their classroom.
- *Visual and oral explanation of expectation will be consistent and serve as the "warning."
- *Violation of policy will result in the following: teacher documents in Jupiter "behavior log" with a notification serving as parent contact AND a consequence based on teacher discretion and severity of violation.
- *Further directions and expectations are up to the teacher to provide on a consistent basis.
- *In an effort to help students honor this contract, we ask that parents and guardians refrain from texting/calling their children during school hours. In case of an emergency, please call the office.

Students who violate daily policy will receive one or more of the following consequences based on teacher discretion:

- 1. Violation logged in to Jupiter and parent notified (all violations shall include this consequence)
- 2. Confiscation of phone, headphones, and/or ear buds until the end of class (teacher drawer/cell phone pocket chart)
- 3. Confiscation of phone, headphones, and/or ear buds until the end of the day (locked in teacher drawer)
- 4. Confiscation of phone, headphones, and/or ear buds and becomes a parent pick up (locked in teacher drawer)
- 5. Loss of future privilege to use phone, headphones, and/or ear buds in that classroom
- 6. Administrators will be involved after blatant disrespect/defiance or multiple violations in a short period of time
- *A locked drawer on teacher's desk/designated area-used when confiscating for full day or parent pick up
- *Cell phone pocket chart/bin/designated area- used when taking for period- student puts in/takes it out at end of class

Board policy- LEUSD Parent/Student Rights and Responsibilities Handbook- "electronic signaling devices" portion (2019-2020 pages 15-16)

Electronic Listening or Recording Device (EC § 51512): The use by any person, including a pupil, of any electronic listening or recording device in any classroom without the prior consent of the teacher and the principal is prohibited as it disrupts and impairs the teaching process and discipline in the schools. Any person other than the pupil, willfully in violation shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. Any pupil in violation shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary action.

Electronic Signaling Devices (EC 48901.5): Elementary, middle and high school students are permitted to have in their possession an electronic signaling device that operates through transmission or receipt of radio waves, including cellular telephones. Such devices shall remain deactivated and put away in the student's backpack, purse, pocket, etc. Their use is strictly prohibited during any instructional time unless the teacher has requested students use their electronic device for instructional purposes.

Students who violate this regulation will be subject to disciplinary action, which can include the following: warning, confiscation, detention and suspension. Exceptions shall be made during an emergency affecting the school or community or with prior written consent for health reasons as directed by a licensed physician or surgeon. The district does not assume liability for lost, stolen, or damaged personal electronic devices.
